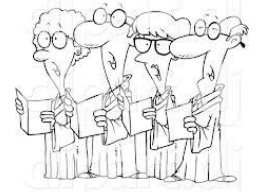
SAFEWAY GIFT CARD ORDERS TODAY!

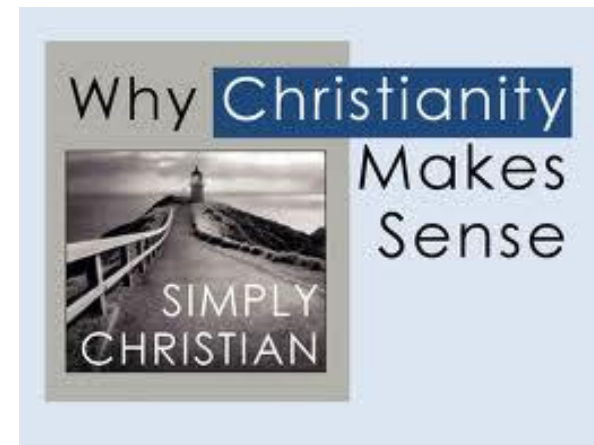
## GOD WILL MAKE A WAY
