

2012 Financial update

You are the best congregation - here is a quote from Dale concerning a preliminary look at our 2012 finances:

"Bottom line, our year to date deficit has been reduced to \$14,472.99. Envelope and PAR Giving's for December had been budgeted to total \$23,354.88. Came in at \$29,692.31. Overall income for the month was \$7,852.74 over budget. In addition to Envelope and PAR exceeding budget, the choir concert raised \$1,707.00 which they put toward operating expenses."

We will still face financial challenges in 2013 for our General Fund. If you can find it in your heart to direct more givings to the General Fund it would be very much appreciated. We do not want a repeat of our financial start to 2012.
