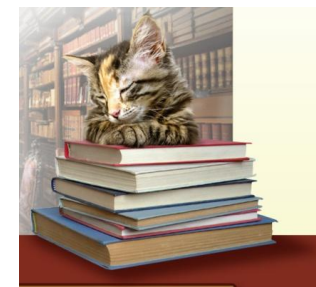
**Become a Mental Health First Aider!**
