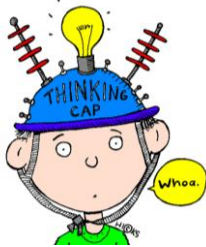

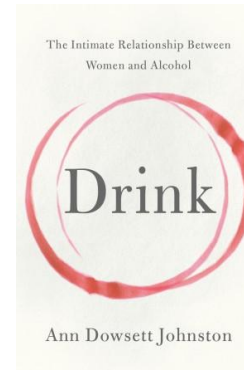

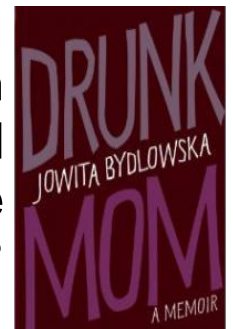
Women and Alcohol
