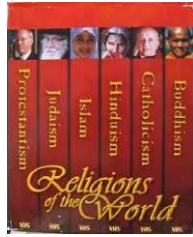

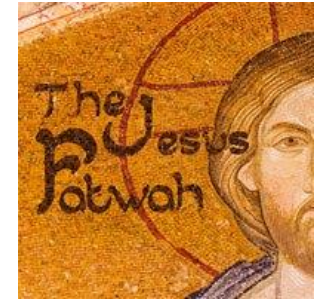
Calling all children who would like to sing!! The first Joyful Noise practice will be on Sunday Oct. 26th at 10 am in the choir room. See you then!
