needed funds for **RAY (Resource Assistance for Youth)** a local charity that supports and serves the hungry, homeless and hurting in the West Broadway area.

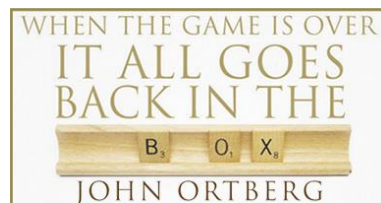
