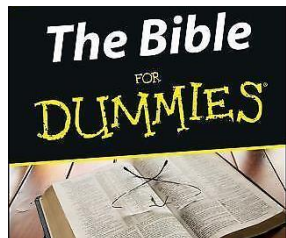
TOT TIME begins again!
