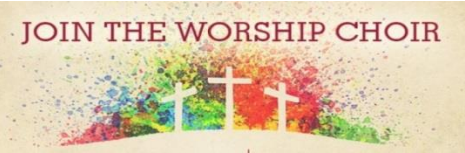


WPUC MUSIC PROGRAMS ARE STARTING SOON!

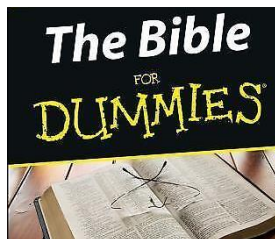
