An Important Message from WPUC Executive Team:

WPUC And Our Changing Ministry Status

Dear WPUC Congregation: As you know, Patrick Woodbeck has been serving our congregation as a student minister. His status will be changing as he will be graduating in May 2018 and will be ordained. Patrick will require a church to offer him a position prior to his graduation. We are required to carry out what is called a **Ministry Profile Process** (previously known as a JNAC) to explore what are our needs and goals for WPUC and for our Minister.
